Legal Holiday Observances

New Year’s Day	Monday, January 3 (observed)
Dr. Martin Luther King Day	Monday, January 17
President’s Day	Monday, February 21
Memorial Day	Monday, May 30
Juneteenth	Monday, June 20 (observed)
Independence Day	Monday, July 4
Labor Day	Monday, September 5
Thanksgiving Day	Thursday, November 24
Christmas Day	Monday, December 26 (observed)

- i. Einstein will operate on a skeleton schedule on the day after Thanksgiving (Friday, November 25). What this means is that staff may work with their departments to take this time off by working a flexible schedule and making up the time at any time prior to the Thanksgiving holiday break. Staff wishing to work on this day may do so by advising their departments.

Jewish Holiday Observances

The schedule below lists the days on which the Jewish holidays for 2022 will fall. All Central Administration offices will be closed on those holidays falling on a weekday and employees in those departments are granted excused time off and are not eligible for paid personal days at any other time during the year. Employees in all other departments who wish to take time off for the Jewish holidays may, with approval of their supervisor, charge the time to accrued personal or vacation days.
