I am pleased to announce the promotion of Catherine Skae, M.D., to senior associate dean for graduate medical education. Dr. Skae is currently senior vice president for graduate medical education and oversees Montefiore's office of graduate medical education and house staff office, as well as interactions with the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education.
