On May 1, 1966, Rose Kennedy and her son Robert broke ground for Einstein's Rose F. Kennedy Center. It opened its doors in 1970, making it one of the oldest centers on the Einstein campus. Today, we are one of the few academic medical centers in the nation that hosts all three of the major intellectual and developmental disabilities research, education/advocacy, and training programs supported by the federal government. These programs, combined with our extensive clinical services, support our dynamic and multifacited dedication to the RFK Center mission.
