## PROPOSAL FOR BIOETHICS INDEPENDENT PRACTICUM: BIOE 5902

This course provides an opportunity for fully matriculated MBE students to design and carry out a semester-long practice-based academic project, under the supervision of a faculty advisor, with some preliminary reading on method of practice (e.g. scholarship on consultation or pedagogy) and writing submitted by term's end. Students may apply for 1-2 academic credits, noting that 1 credit typically requires 100 hours of practice-based work. Approval for credit will be granted on an individual basis, after review by the Center and the Registrar, upon which the student will be registered for a given term, with the faculty advisor as instructor of record responsible for evaluation. Proposals will need:

- **Detailed plan of practice** (including reading on method, scheduled meetings with advisor, venue and time for practice, and proposed writing/presentation/publication at the end)
- **Term paper** submitted at the end of practice period.
