## **Montefiore Goes Smoke-Free**

March 23rd 2011, Montefiore Medical Center will declare a Smoke-Free Campus Policy. All properties owned, leased, or operated by the Medical Center will be designated smoke-free areas. The policy applies to all Montefiore associates, patients, and visitors. By committing to a smoke-free campus policy, Montefiore, the largest healthcare provider and teaching organization in the Bronx shows its dedication to the health and well-being of its employees, patients, visitors, and local communities. It has been proven that limiting the number of places where people can smoke encourages smokers to quit. As the largest employer in the Bronx, NY employing an estimated 17,000 associates and providing care to over one third of all Bronx residents, this shift is bound to have a tremendous impact.

Montefiore's plan to transition into a Smoke-free campus was first broadcasted internally on November 18th 2010, the date of the American Cancer Society's annual

Great American Smoke Out. In a letter from the President and CEO, Steven M. Safyer, MD, it was announced that Montefiore would go smoke -free this March by extending the no-smoking zones beyond the 25-foot perimeters to include entire hospital campuses, public areas such as garages, common areas in residential buildings and community based sites. President Safyer stated, "We want everyone who comes to us for care to experience a healthy, tobacco –free environment and for our community to be free of health burdens associated with smoking."

This time last year, in sync with Kick Butts Day on March 24, 2010, Montefiore Medical Center kicked off "To Your Health!" – A Worksite Wellness Program. The program offered Tobacco Cessation workshops at all major Montefiore locations. In this same time frame Montefiore's Office of Community Health established a Tobacco-Free Campus Task Force, chaired by Director Peter Selwyn, MD, MPH. The Task-Force made up of associates from across the medical center worked diligently to assess the unique needs of the complex health system. Then with the support of community partners, including the Bronx BREATHES staff, the Task Force presented recommendations on steps to create a tobacco-free campus at Montefiore. On Wednesday, March 23th, Kick Butts Day 2011, Montefiore celebrates the culmination of its efforts and officially declares a smoke-free Campus!
