On October 27, 2016 by unanimous vote at the General Meeting of the Russian Academy of Sciences, Solomon Moshé was elected Foreign Member of the Russian Academy of Sciences

Dr. Shlomo Shinnar is a member of the executive committee and cochair of the adjudication core of the ESETT (Established Status Epilepticus Treatment Trial). This NINDS funded study seek to determine the optimal therapy for patients in status epilepticus who failed to respond to first line therapy with a benzodizepene. It is comparing fosphenytoin, leviteracetam and valproate. The studies includes children adults and the elderly. There will be sufficient number of children enrolled to separately determine optimal treatment in children. Recruitment is going well though, since the study is blinded, it will be some time before results are available.

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
# **Epilepsy Walk**

NINDS has just funded a trial "Dietary treatment of Glucose transporter Type 1 Deficiency" with the PI being Dr Juan Pascal at UT Southwestern. Glut 1 is rare disorders with manifestation including seizures and cognitive disability. This is a novel approach to try and reverse the underlying metabolic problem with dietary manipulations. Dr. Shlomo Shinnar is a member of the executive committee advising on clinical trial design and execution and assessment of outcomes.
