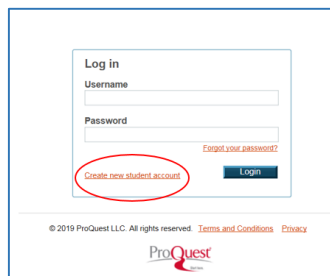
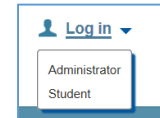


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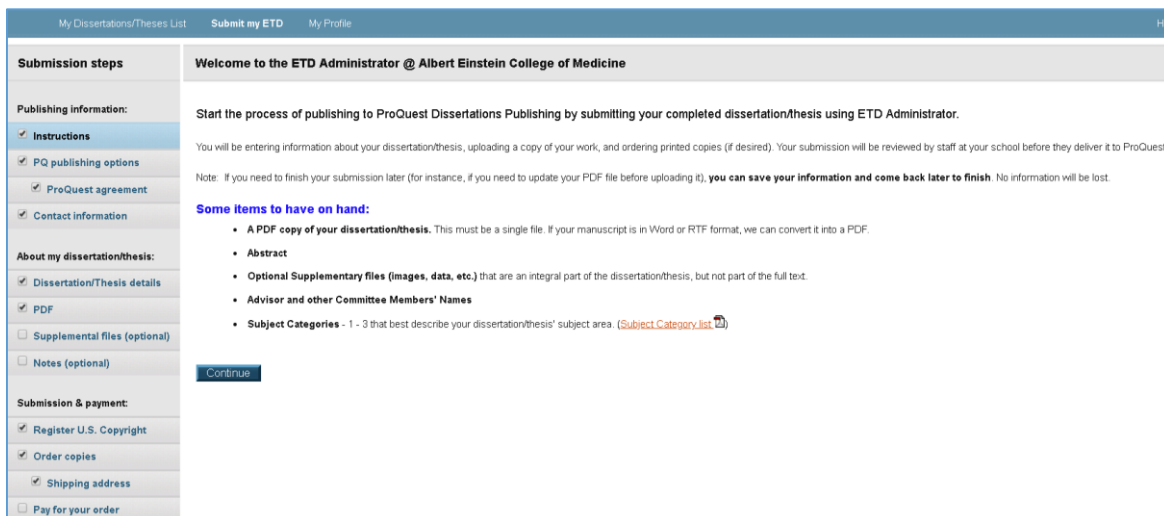
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Submitting the Dissertation

Once you’re logged in, you’ll see instructions on what you will need in order to complete your submission. Click the “Continue” button.



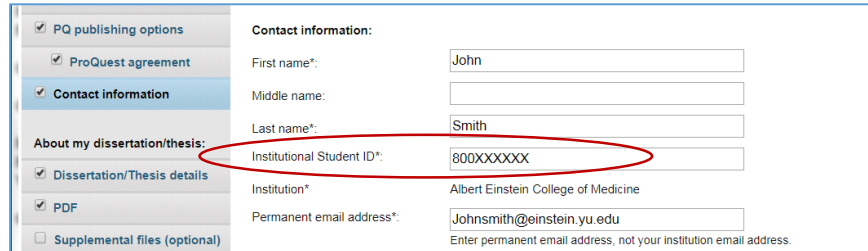
At the end of each step you’ll be prompted to “Save & Continue”. Required fields will be marked with an asterisk (*). You may return to a previous step at any time by clicking the link in the left-hand menu to navigate to different

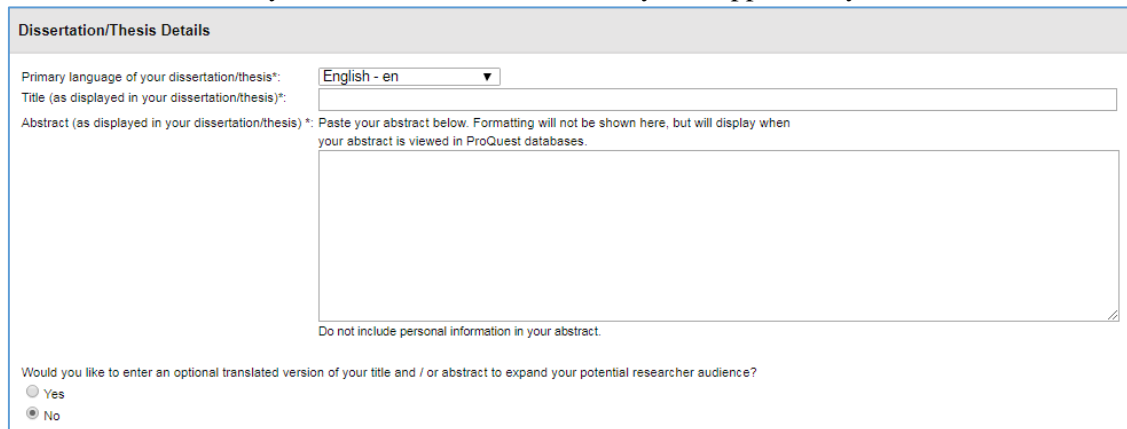

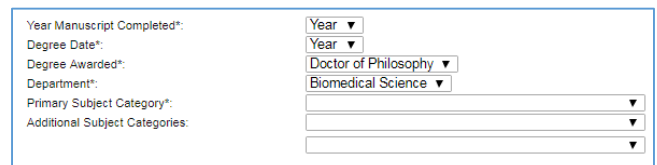
